THE 2012 WORLD CHOIR GAMES IN CINCINNATI

From Wednesday, July 4 to Saturday, July 14, the City of Cincinnati is hosting the World Choir Games, the first one in the United States. An event nicknamed "The Olympics of Choral Music" is expected to bring 15,000 choir members and more than 200,000 spectators from all over the world. 362 choirs from 64 countries are coming. The games are organized by INTERKULTUR of Pohlheim, Germany and are held every two years in a different city and country. The first one was held in 2000 in Linz, Austria followed by Busan, Korea in 2002, Bremen, Germany in 2004, Xiamen, China 2006, Graz, Austria, 2008, Shaoxing, China 2010.

It takes 4600 volunteers to run the 200 events in nine different locations in Cincinnati and Covington. Some time ago, we signed up as choir guides and interpreters. We attended an indoctrination meeting on Tuesday, June 19 where we received a badge, shirt, hat and a backpack with assorted trinkets and coupons. At this time we are assigned to a choir from Graz in the Steiermark Region of Austria. Our shifts are from 7 am to 1 pm from July 4 to July 8. We report to supervisors in the Convention Center where we get our instructions. Free parking is in a lot west of the Roebling Suspension Bridge; from there a free shuttle takes us to the Convention Center. Sometimes I wonder why we signed up for this volunteer job but on the other hand it's a once in a lifetime experience to be involved in such a grand spectacle. Thanks to the initiative of the late Maestro Erich Kunzel of the Cincinnati Pops Orchestra, Cincinnati was chosen over 20 other cities. Two members of the Kolping Saengerchor have been very active as facilitators; they are Karin Kraeling and Doris Aberman and they deserve our sincere thanks.
