SPECIAL ELECTION

Due to an over sight at the November Election, the position of National Delegate was not put up for nomination. As per the Cincinnati Kolping bylaws; Article VI, Section 7, this position is voted on the opposite year from that of the President. The person that is elected to this position: Shall represent the membership at the National Conventions and Board of Directors meetings. They shall be the liaison between the Society and the National Society. They shall keep a roster of all members with names, addresses, occupation, and date of admission. They shall provide the National Society with membership changes, addresses changes, and a correct mailing list for the Banner mailing list. They shall report to the membership after a National Board meeting or Convention. All expenses incurred by the National Delegate on official Kolping business, including travel, hotel, and meals will be paid by the Society, unless the National Society reimburses them. As the National Delegate they are also a member of the Cincinnati Kolping Board with full voting rights.

This term of office expires on December 31, 2014.

Nominations will be accepted until the April, 2013 General meeting, with voting at the May business meeting. All paid up members with two years of membership are eligible to be candidates.

Effective December 1, 2012, the Fr. David Hiller Fund will offer two (2) \$2500 grants to children of **active** Kolping parents.
