- **Zodiac I PA**, India pale ale with 7% ABV.

Don't forget to pay your Kolping Dues!

Membership Dues are payable in January. If dues are not paid by **April 1, 2014**, your membership will be terminated. This is in the Kolping by-laws per, article XIV explaining dues. If dues are not paid, you will not be allowed to participate in Kolping functions such as shooting or shooting for king, etc. Also, if you don't pay your dues by **April 1, 2014** and still want to be a member, you must be re-initiated.

\$42.00 for a **Single Membership** \$63.00 for a **Family Membership** (both spouses must be Kolping Members)

\$25.00 for a **Life Membership** (to be paid each year after 70 yrs. of age and a member for at least 20 years OR as a member of the Armed Forces on ACTIVE DUTY)

Kolping History

While on the hunt for Kolping historical memorabilia, we came across a handwritten letter from Harry Talkers. It was undated, but from the mention of 67 years, it was probably written in 1991. It is entitled, "History – Historic Research Team Wanted" and reads, "We are making history everyday in our Society, so now it is time to form a team to keep records of it all. Through the urgent insistence of Toni Ahrnsen to us younger people, we owe it to our old timers to keep better records. Our Society was founded in 1924 by 12 young men coming from Germany. None of them had a college education, but they were proud to be expert craftsmen. Now, 67 years later, our members have educated their children to be highly professional people. We have many records and books to be sorted, so we ask everybody in the Society to

become part of it. We would like to invite high school

students to senior citizens to be part of our team, especially if your interest is in history, journalism, genealogy and volunteering to help our Kolping Society. As soon as we have enough volunteers, we will set up our first meeting." Please volunteer by calling: Harry Talkers (phone number).

Now, it is twenty-three years later and the pieces of the Kolping history are still waiting to be discovered and brought to light for all to see and know. Toni Ahrnsen (1907-1997) and Harry had a good idea in 1991 and we will do our best to make their hopes come true. This can only be done with the help of many members. Please try to locate pieces of our history and we will be happy to preserve in the book whatever you find.

In the last month, we have been able to locate and scan into the computer nearly 800 photographs and documents relating to the history of the Cincinnati Kolping Society. Many thanks to Marilee and Gunther Uhlhorn, Elizabeth and Clem Ricke, Norb Schomaker, Jim Slouffman, Harry Talkers and Manfred and Regina Schnetzer for providing items spanning about seventy years of our history. Thanks also to the Tegenkamps and Wilkes for allowing us to assault them on a daily basis with emails in an effort to identify the many faces in old photographs. If anyone else would like to be on the Photo Identification Squad, just send us your e-mail address.

We found a file from the late 1920s and early 1930s containing all of the correspondence relating to the establishment of the Kolping House at 1523 Kolping Service Awards, both locally and on the national level. We have the name lists of those who have received these awards but would like some photos of the occasions. Perhaps the recipients have these photos.

We haven't found much relating to the various sports clubs over the last ninety years. Surely, there are many members who were instrumental in developing this important aspect of the Kolping

Republic Street. Also found was a picture taken in the summer of 1924 at the Cincinnati Zoo, likely showing many or all of the founding members. Many thanks to Manfred Schnetzer who is in the process of translating meeting minutes and other documents from the 1930s. Thanks also to Elizabeth Ricke who has some documents to translate. They could both use some help if anyone is willing.

Here are some things we hope members can find.

Obviously, Schützenfest is a large part of our history. We have located the King's Ball invitation portraits of kings and queens for the following thirty-eight years: 1948, 1949, 1963, 1965-1975, 1978, 1980-1984, 1988-1989, 1993-1994, 1996-2003, 2006-2010, and 2013. Do we have yours?

We have located King's Court pictures from the following twenty-seven years: 1960-1962, 1964-1966, 1968-1969, 1972-1974, 1978-1980, 1983, 1988, 1991, 1993, 1998, 2000-2003, 2005-2006, **2008, and 2010.** Do we have yours?

We would also like to have lists containing all the names of the court members from all years. We already have the lists from the following nine years: 1972, 1978, 1983, 2000, 2001, 2006, 2007, 2008, and 2013. Do we have yours?

If you know the children or grandchildren of members from long ago, we would like to find out from them if they still possess any parts of our history that they would be willing to share. Please pass along our contact information or give us the necessary information to contact them. Over the years, many members have received

Society, and have information/photos, etc. that need to be preserved.

Does anyone have construction or renovation pictures of the facilities on Winton Road?

We stand ready to go anywhere at any time to get more information. We're only a phone call or an email message away!
