

Ferdi was also awarded the Kolping Meritorious Service Award in 1983 and the National Kolping Distinguished Service Award in 1984. We extend our sympathies to his son Greg and his daughter Sandra, as well as to the extended Kappen family.

Otger Kappen, husband of the late Maria Kappen, brother to Kolping members Anneliese Loesing Schulten and the late Ferdi Kappen, father to Kolping member Mike Kappen and grandfather to Kolping member Spencer Kappen, passed away on March 15, 2019 at the age of 86. Otger was a member of Kolping for 61 years and was president of the Society from 1966-1967 and from 1994-1995.
