Note from the President

Do you have a key to the Kolping Center front and back door? Do you know anyone else who has a key? Many people have keys, but we do not have a record of who they are.

In order to better control the number of keys outstanding and the identity of who has access to our building, the Board has approved a system to connect your key with your own unique 4-digit code to permit you to arm or disarm the alarm system when you enter or leave the building. A log book will be maintained which will identify key holders with their unique codes.

Barb Hessler has agreed to be the control point for this system. **Everyone who currently has a key needs to contact Barb BEFORE FEBRUARY 28, 2019** to give a reason for having a key and to be assigned your own 4-digit code. Anyone who currently is in possession of a key who no longer has a need for it, should turn the key in to either Tom Musbach or Barb Hessler. **The existing master code will be disabled after March 1, 2019.** Please be aware that if you input the wrong code or attempt to use the old master code, the alarm will be set off, and the police will be notified.

The Deadline for the Father David Hiller Fund Scholarships is Approaching!!!!

Once again, the Fr. David Hiller Fund will offer two (2) \$3,000 grants to children of **active** Kolping parents. At least one parent must be a member for at least three years. Grants are available for children who will be freshmen at a Greater Cincinnati Catholic high school in the school year 2019-2020. These grants will be renewable for each successive school year, provided certain conditions are met.

In 2019, the grants will be awarded to the two freshman students. Current grant recipients are also required to reapply in order to receive their renewable grants. Applications and program description are available in the Hiller Fund mail slot in the Kolping Board room. Applications should be sent directly to the Cincinnati Scholarship Foundation, who will determine the awardees. The applications are not provided to the members of the FDHF Committee.
